<u>Eligibility criteria for candidates who wish to take the</u> <u>Scholarship Merit Test 2014 :</u>

- **1.** Citizenship : Applicant must be a citizen of India.
- 2. Age Restriction :

a) Engineering / Technology (other than Marine Engineering), Architecture Courses :

Candidates **must be at least** 17 (seventeen) years of age as on 31.12.2014. There is no upper age limit.

b) Marine Engineering course :

Candidates **must be at least** 17 (seventeen) years of age or above as on 31.12.2014 and **must not be above** 25 (twenty five) years of age as on 31.07.2014; as per guidelines of appropriate authority.

c) Medical / Dental courses :

Candidates **must be at least** 17 (seventeen) years of age as on 31.12.2014. There is no upper age limit.

<u>Eligibility criteria for candidates who would be awarded</u> <u>Scholarships in the Merit Test 2014 :</u>

Engineering (All Discipline)

- 1. Candidates who make it within the first 100 (one hundred) in the Scholarship Merit Test 2014.
- 2. Candidate should have secured a place in any University/ Government Institution or any Govt recognised Institution in the chosen Engineering discipline after qualifying in JEE 2014 in any state of India.
- 3. Candidates who are pursuing their Engg/Med can also apply for the Scholarship Merit Test. In such a case their Scholarship is available from 2014 only.
- 4. All other eligibility criteria required to study Engineering from the academic year 2014.

Medical / Dental

- 1. Candidates who make it within the first 20 (twenty) in the Scholarship Merit Test 2014.
- 2. Candidate should have secured a place in any University/ Government Institution or any Govt recognised Institution in Medicine / Dental after qualifying in JEE 2014 in 2014 in any state of India.
- 3. Candidates who are pursuing their Engg/Med can also apply for the Scholarship Merit Test. In such a case their Scholarship is available from 2014 only.
- 4. All other eligibility criteria required to study Medicine / Dental from the academic year 2014.

NB:

- Should there be a situation wherein a candidate is successful in the scholarship merit test 2014 but fails to qualify in JEE 2014 (Engg / Med) then the opportunity will pass on to the next candidate from the merit list.
